**Course Description:** This three-day HT class will have a survivor debrief their experience with questions and answers to help officers gain expertise in human trafficking. This course has been updated with new debriefs from recent survivors and human trafficking investigations. This class will also address different types of human trafficking and new trends that are developing among traffickers. This class will discuss human trafficking laws and how they affect law enforcement. The class will give patrol officers, investigators, and supervisors additional tools on how to recognize human trafficking indicators within their communities and how to take enforcement action against perpetrators of these crimes. Investigators who attend this training will learn how to use a variety of tools to successfully investigate, takedown, and prosecute traffickers and their criminal enterprises.
